**Potential Weaknesses**

- ❑ The Writer does not accept native PostScript, AFP or Xerox DJDE/Metacode file formats. Most of the competitors say they have this capability.
- ❑ The Writer does not accept gray scale images. Several packages exist to convert Gray & JPEG to bi-tonal TIFF
