Last fall, **Business Solutions Magazine's** (BSM) VAR subscribers were asked to participate in the Best Channel Vendors survey. BSM asked subscribers to rate their vendor partners on a scale of 0 (worst) to 5 (best) in several categories. Here's a summary of how Kodak Alaris scored:

Service/Support: 4.40
Channel Friendly: 4.40
Channel Program: 4.20
Product Features: 4.80
Product Reliability: 4.80
Product Innovation: 4.40

More than 5,400 votes were cast in the Best Channel Vendor survey, making it one of the largest of its kind. Scores were tallied by the BSM editorial staff using a methodology provided by Penn State University.
