Top 5 Reasons **NOT** to Choose Fujitsu

1. Compare actual scanning throughput speed

Scanner	Claimed Speed	Actual Speed (200 dpi color duplex)
Kodak Scan Station 500	30 pages per minute	30.3 pages per minute*
Fujitsu fi-6010N Network Scanner	25 pages per minute	20.3 pages per minute*

* Transport speed test settings: 200 dpi, color, duplex, PDF format.

2. Scan and scan again!

- Cannot send to multiple destinations at the same time—must rescan each document for each destination

3. Workload limitations

- Testing shows that Fujitsu's paper transport design (with only one feed roller) delivers inconsistent paper feeding performance
- Must scan embossed cards one at a time
- Glossy business cards often jam
- Mixed-batch scanning requires extra document preparation
- Cannot scan to portable USB drives
- ADF only holds 50 sheets (20 lb. paper)
- Recommended daily use is only 1,000 pages

4. Need to send a message? Start typing!

- No ability to send a voice message attachment

5. Limited options for document feeding

- No A3 or A4 flatbed scanner available
