# Top 5 Reasons **NOT** to Choose HP

## 1. Compare actual scanning throughput speed

HP 9250c Digital Sender	33 images per minute	18.7 images per minute*

## 2. With the **HP 9250c Digital Sender**, you must physically type any accompanying messages

- No ability to send an audio message attachment

## 3. Ergonomically challenged

- Extremely noisy, especially in duplex mode
- Large footprint takes up lots of desktop space
- Low-resolution, black-and-white touch screen is difficult to read

## 4. Limited "scan to" destinations

- No scanning to portable USB drives
- No scan-to-fax (LAN fax only)

## 5. Paper handling limitations

- ADF capacity is only 50 sheets (20 lb. paper)
- Extra document preparation required to prevent jams when scanning mixed batches
- No ADF scanning for embossed cards or business cards
